1. PURPOSE OF THE MoU

2.4 Promotion of joint academic and research initiatives, subject to separate written agreements wherever required.

3. ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE FIRST PARTY

3.1 The First Party shall design and deliver skill-development programs through qualified and experienced industry professionals.

3.2 The First Party shall share the proposed training curriculum, duration, and learning outcomes with the Second Party in advance for academic review and approval.

3.3 The First Party may issue certificates of participation/completion, which shall be co-branded with the logos and names of both Parties, subject to mutual approval.

3.4 The First Party shall comply with applicable laws, ethical standards, and data protection norms while executing activities under this MoU.

4. ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE SECOND PARTY

4.1 The Second Party shall facilitate communication with students and faculty regarding the programs conducted under this MoU.

4.2 Participation of students in any training or internship program shall be purely voluntary and subject to eligibility criteria and student consent.

4.3 The Second Party shall retain full academic control and ensure that activities conducted under this MoU align with PCI, UGC, and institutional regulations.

4.4 The Second Party shall collect structured feedback from participants and share a summary with the First Party for quality improvement

5. FEES AND FINANCIAL TERMS

5.1 Any fees payable by students or the institution for training programs shall be communicated transparently in advance.

5.2 This MoU does not create any financial liability on either Party unless expressly agreed upon in writing.

6. DATA PROTECTION AND CONFIDENTIALITY

- 6.1 Any data collected during the collaboration shall be limited to academic and training-related purposes only.
- 6.2 Personal data of students and faculty shall be shared with the First Party and shall be handled in compliance with applicable data protection laws of India.
- 6.3 Both Parties agree to maintain confidentiality of shared information and shall not disclose the same to third parties without prior written consent.

7. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY AND RESEARCH

- 7.1 Any joint research, publications, or intellectual property arising out of this collaboration shall be governed by separate written agreements clearly defining authorship, ownership, and publication rights.

8. BRANDING AND PUBLICITY

- 8.1 Both Parties may mutually agree to co-promote activities under this MoU through banners, websites, and social media platforms.
- 8.2 Use of each other's name, logo, or branding shall require prior written approval.

9. DURATION AND TERMINATION

- 9.1 This MoU shall be valid for a period of five (05) years from the effective date.
- 9.2 The MoU may be extended upon mutual review and written consent of both Parties.
- 9.3 Either Party may terminate this MoU by giving 30 days' prior written notice without assigning any reason.

10. LEGAL STATUS AND DISPUTE RESOLUTION

- 10.1 This MoU is a statement of intent and does not constitute a legally binding partnership or employment relationship.
- 10.2 Any disputes arising shall be resolved amicably through mutual discussions.
