Industrial visit to Srinija parenterals ,perecherla,Guntur District was organized on 22/04/2023 by G.V.Subramanyam Associate Professor , Department of Pharmaceutical Analysis & B.Sudheer chowdary, Assistant professor , Department of pharmacology for II/IV B.Pharm students. A total of 102 students of II/IV B.Pharmacy had participated in industrial visit for enhancing their knowledge and skills.

During the visit students were intoduced with Srinija Parenterals and the importance of various parenteral dosage forms and their applications. The Technical Incharge Officer explained the students about different types of parenteral formulations which were being manufactured in the plant.
