- Infrastructure and Learning Resources

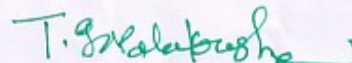
Institution provides Internet facility in class rooms and Wi-Fi facilities. Institution has purchased sophisticated instruments and subscribed to e- journals.
